

Meeting Procedures and Voting Rules

2020 Annual General Meeting

VIA WEBINAR

1. The annual general meeting will be conducted according to parliamentary rules of procedure as set out in the latest edition of Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised.
2. The President of the College, or, in the President's absence, the Vice President, will Chair the annual general meeting.

The Council may retain a parliamentarian to assist in chairing a meeting of the College.

3. Members in Good Standing are eligible to attend and participate in the annual general meeting.

To state your question or comment during the meeting the protocol is to type your first and last name, email address and question or comment in the Question tab which is in the platform menu.

4. Quorum for the annual general meeting is twenty-five (25) Regulated Members in Good Standing.

If at the Call to Order quorum is not present, the meeting will be adjourned for one-half (0.5) hour after which time the meeting may reconvene and quorum will consist of the Regulated Members in Good Standing present.

5. Only Regulated Members in Good Standing may vote at the annual general meeting.

Each Regulated Member in Good Standing will have one (1) vote per matter. In the event of a tie vote, the Chair may cast the deciding vote. Voting by proxy is not permitted.

6. A motion will be decided by an online poll vote, a declaration by the Chair that a motion on a poll vote has been dealt with is conclusive proof that the motion has been dealt with.
